2018 IIAS Congress

Tunis, Tunisia

25-29 June 2018

The 2018 Congress of the International Institute of Administrative Sciences will take place at the National School of Administration in Tunis, Tunisia from 25 to 29 June.

It will focus on the theme of **Administrative Resilience**. Administrative resilience refers to the ability of governance systems to cope with external pressures, maintain themselves, avoid collapse, and achieve policy outcomes. Accordingly, the 2018 IIAS Congress will address this question: how can governance systems address the contemporary societal challenges?

We are pleased to invite you to contribute to this debate by submitting a panel proposal for the Congress. A panel proposal should have:

- a title
- one chair or several co-chairs with their e-mail and institutional affiliation and
- a call-for-papers explaining how the theme of administrative resilience is approached and what kind of contributions are expected.

It should not include paper or speaker proposals. This call is open to academics and practitioners alike.

Please submit your panel proposal to s.troupin@iias-iisa.org before **15 September 2017**. The IIAS Congress scientific committee will review the panel proposals, on basis of their quality and relevance for the Congress theme and the field of public administration and governance in general.

Accepted call for papers of the panel will be published online, on the IIAS Congress website, **by 2 October 2017**. Interested individuals will be free to submit paper proposals until late 2017.

The panel co-chairs will be in charge of the paper selection.
The number of sessions granted to each panel will depend on the number of selected papers.

Panel co-chairs and presenters will have to cover their transportation, accommodation and registration costs. Discounts will be granted to panel co-chairs, PhD students, and IIAS members.
